Dublin:

Home to the Memorial Golf Tournament, Muirfield Village, the Columbus Zoo and more, Dublin is probably the most well-known Columbus suburb. Dublin is also one of the largest suburbs because it is home to numerous corporate headquarters, two malls, one historic downtown district, and more. As many visitors say, "there is always something happening in Dublin."

Area Attractions:

- **The Chiller in Dublin:** 7001 Dublin Park Drive, 614-764-1000. The Chiller Ice Skating Facility features two NHL-size ice rinks, locker rooms, party and meeting rooms, concession area and the Blue Jackets pro shop. The Chiller offers public skating seven days a week, with afternoon and evening hours.
- **Columbus Zoo & Aquarium:** 9990 Riverside Drive, Powell, 614-645-3400. Located six miles north of the I-270 outerbelt (exit 20) next to Wyandot Lake. Enjoy exotic animals, lush gardens and entertaining, educational programs. Open daily 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Memorial Day to Labor Day).
- **Dublin Arts Council:** 7125 Riverside Drive, Dublin, 614-889-7444. Displays monthly exhibits by local, regional and national artists. The Dublin Arts Center is open to the public Tuesday & Wednesday 9 am to 9 pm; Thursday & Friday 9 am to 5 pm; and Saturday 9 am to 3 pm.
- **Golf Center at Sports Ohio:** 6100 Dublin Park Drive, 614-791-3002. The Golf Center encompasses 35 acres including Central Ohio's only pitch and putt par 3, driving range with 36 two-tiered heated tees, 20-tee private instructional area, 100 manicured outdoor tees, natural putting green, synthetic grass putting green and chipping green.
- **Polaris Fashion Mall:** Polaris Mall in Columbus, Ohio, is the state's largest shopping mall, on Polaris Parkway in Delaware County. It's on the northern edge of Columbus. The anchor stores are JC Penney, Kaufman's, Lazarus, Lord and Taylor, Saks Fifth Avenue, Sears. There are over 160 other smaller stores, with lots of opportunities for shopping and dining.
- **Tuttle Crossing Mall:** The Mall at Tuttle Crossing, located on Tuttle Crossing Blvd. at I-270, is a 980,000 square foot mall with over 120 stores and a food court. Although three of Tuttle's four anchors are standard fare - JC Penney, Sears, Macys - the mall boasts many retailers new to Central Ohio. Tuttle includes amenities such as year-round valet parking, a cappuccino bar, and a children's play area.
