***PROFILE 1:*** (Emergency) In some agencies, there would be short-term involvement (up to 90 days). In other agencies, this family would be referred to community services, no case would be opened.

***PROFILE 2:*** (Situational) The family has begun a cycle of maladaptive behavior, which can be altered by a change in one/two areas of functioning. There is low-moderate risk to the child.

***PROFILE 3-A:*** (Multiple Needs) The family has a host of problems, including several risk factors that are contributing to CA/N. There is moderate-high risk to the child. The family appears to be non-violent, non-threatening and willing to work with the agency.

***PROFILE 3-B:*** (Multiple Needs) The family has a host of problems, including several risk factors that are contributing to CA/N. There is high risk to the child. The family appears angry and hostile.

***PROFILE 4:*** (Multiple Needs with a History Of Violence) The family has a host of problems, including several risk factors that are contributing to CA/N. Multiple behavioral changes are needed to reduce risk sufficiently to reunite the child with the family.

***LOW-MODERATE RELATIONSHIP:*** FP has a low to moderate willingness to partner with birth families for the safe and speedy reunification of the child and family.

***MODERATE-HIGH RELATIONSHIP:*** FP has a moderate to high willingness to partner with birth families for the safe and speedy reunification of the child.

*\*The number of weeks in this timeframe signifies the number of weeks throughout a case (longest being a year, 52 weeks).*
