

Athens County Family and Children First Coordinator

The Athens County Family and Children First Council (FCFC) is seeking qualified applicants for the position of FCFC Coordinator. The Coordinator manages activities of the FCFC including oversight of grants, data collection for outcomes for programs, coordinating the multi-agency system for children, representing and/or advocating for the Council on state and local groups. As Coordinator of the system of care for children, must have experience and knowledge of multi-system youth and be able to participate in the development of child specific treatment plans.

Responsible for management of FCFC budget, tracking of data, and ensuring compliance with various state policies. Must be able to collaborate with local and state partners and the ability to support children with multiple needs and their families.

Athens County Children Services is the administrative agent for the FCFC Council. The Coordinator will be an employee of the agency with full benefits and 35 hours per week.

Applicants must have a Bachelor's degree in a social service and have experience in planning and implementing practices in social service systems. Applicant must have knowledge and treatment planning experience with multi-system youth.
