

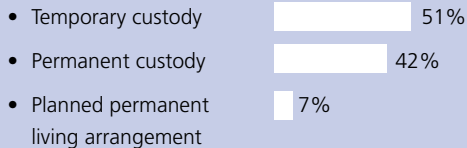

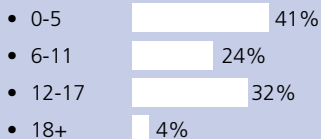

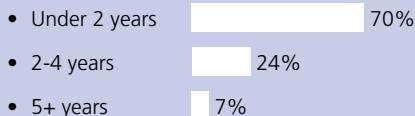

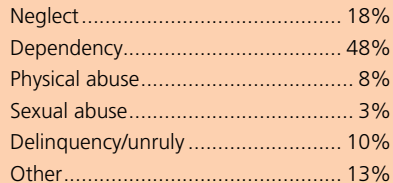

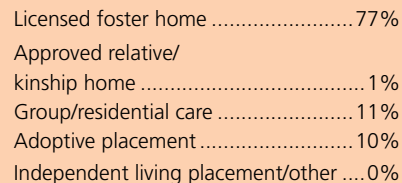

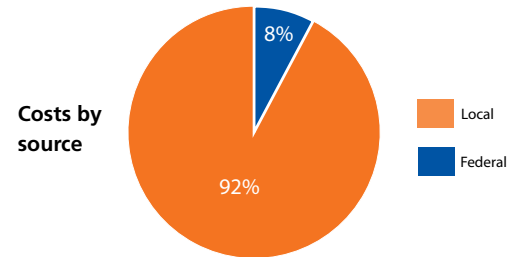

PLACEMENT COSTS

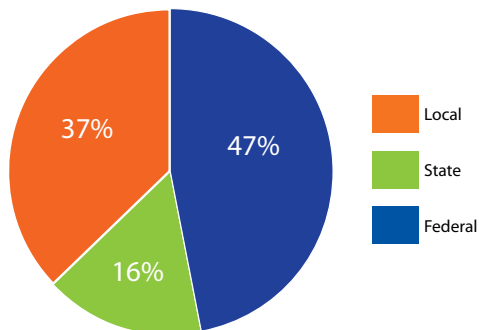
