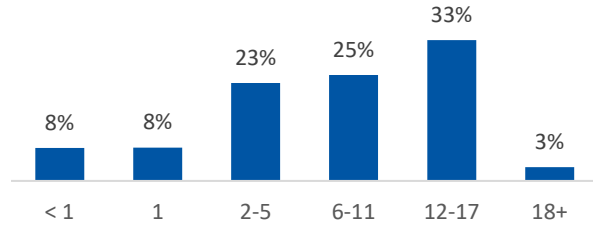

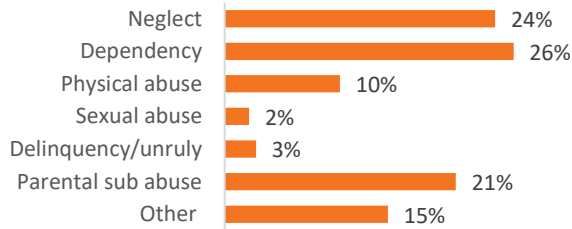

### Age in Years



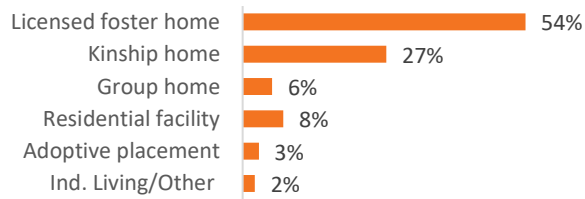

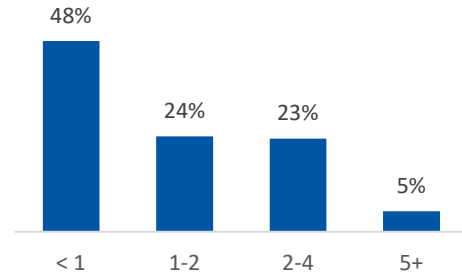

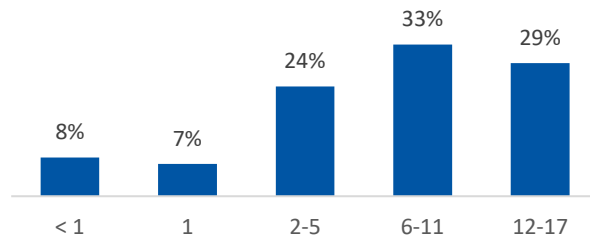

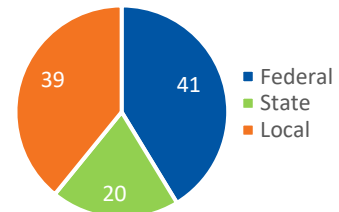

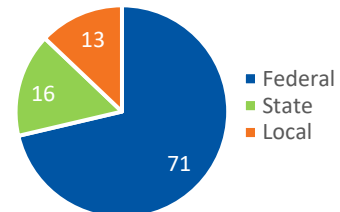
### Adoption Assistance and Subsidies

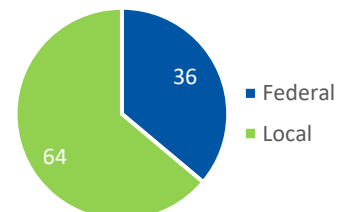

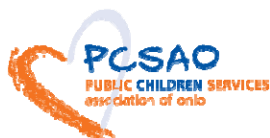
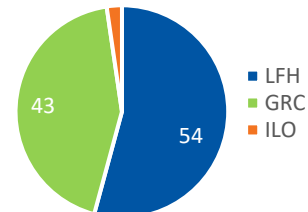
