Dr. Brad Lander is a Clinical Psychologist and Licensed Independent Chemical Dependency Counselor who has worked in Columbus since 1979 in a variety of chemical dependency and mental health positions. Dr. Lander graduated With Highest Distinction and Phi Beta Kappa from Purdue University, and received his Masters and Doctorate degrees from The Ohio State University in counseling psychology. Dr. Lander first began working in the treatment field as a mental health therapist in the community mental health and VA systems. He began specializing in chemical dependency in 1985. In 2001, Dr. Lander became the Clinical Director of Addiction Medicine at The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center more commonly known as Talbot Hall. Dr. Lander serves as a board member and faculty with The Ohio State University Institute of Addiction Studies. He has received the President's Award for Outstanding Service in the Field of Substance Abuse and the 2010 Excellence in Community Health Education Award.
