PFSN has a managed care contract with Franklin County Children Services (FCCS) to provide and coordinate direct care services to families. PFSN is seeking a staff attorney to represent PFSN in Franklin County Juvenile Court in abuse, neglect, dependency, unruly, and delinquency cases. The job duties include representing the legal interest of PFSN on a daily basis; drafting motions and complaints; advising PFSN staff on legal issues regarding PFSN; training new workers; tracking cases; organizing and preparing docket system; facilitating permanency planning meetings.

- Ensure that PFSN has legal representation in all post-dispositional cases, and pre-disposition case upon request.

- File emergency custody orders.
