Role Description

This is a full-time hybrid role for a Registered Nurse at Franklin County Children Services. As a Registered Nurse, you will be responsible for providing high-quality care to children in need. Your day-to-day tasks will include conducting health assessments, administering medications, providing medical treatments, coordinating with healthcare providers, and monitoring the well-being of children under your care. Although this position is primarily based in Columbus, Ohio Metropolitan Area, there is flexibility for some remote work.

Key Responsibilities

- 30%** Reviews and processes consent for hospital treatment, admission, surgeries, and medications for children in Agency custody.
- 30%** Conducts medical screenings for children of all ages to screen for and document illness, injury or other medical concerns for further assessment or treatment.
- 30%** Visits client homes and foster homes to provide medical consultation, advice, and assessment of children; advises social workers and caregivers on medical matters in coordination with the medical team; monitors caregiver

compliance with medical care and communicates accordingly with FCCS staff and medical teams.

5% Attends staff development training meetings and other unit/department meetings.

5% Performs other related duties as assigned

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing and valid Registered Nurse (RN) license
- Experience in pediatric or mental health nursing
- Strong knowledge of child health and development
- Ability to assess and respond to medical emergencies
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work collaboratively with a multidisciplinary team
- Experience working with children who have experienced trauma
- CPR and first aid certification
- Knowledge of child welfare laws and regulations
- Strong organizational and time-management skills
- Ability to work independently and make sound decisions
