Minimum Class Requirements:

CWC 1 - BA/BS in Social Work or related area and one year of experience in social work. Will consider BS/BA in Social Work with field placement in social work.

CWC 2 – Master’s in Social Work or related field. Preference given to candidates with field placements or volunteer experience involving casework responsibility with families and children -OR- BA/BS in Social Work or related field and at least two (2) years of related experience preferably in Child Welfare.

CWC 3 - Master's Degree in Social Work or closely related field with two (2) years of experience including Child Welfare, Mental Health, or Family Services -OR- Bachelor's in Social Work or closely related field plus five (5) years of Social Work experience in Child Welfare, Family Service or Mental Health.

Training & Development:

All applicants who are extended a conditional offer of employment will be required to take and successfully pass a screening for substance abuse before beginning work.
